ORDINANCE NO. 2021-34

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CERTAIN POLICE MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT WITH THE VILLAGE OF CUYAHOGA HEIGHTS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village wishes to provide expanded emergency response capabilities through increased police protection; and

WHEREAS, the Villages wishes to improve law enforcement services to its residents by making the most efficient use of its manpower;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL FOR THE VILLAGE OF NEWBURGH HEIGHTS, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:


Section 1: Village Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to enter into a certain Police Mutual Aid Agreement with the Village of Cuyahoga Heights, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A, and which is incorporated herein by reference as if fully rewritten.

Section 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal action occurred in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the Village of Newburgh Heights, such emergency being the need to promptly renew the mutual aid agreement with the Village of Cuyahoga Heights so that citizens of both communities may enjoy the benefit of increased police protection through additional manpower; wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of four (4) or more of the members elected or appointed to this Council, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest time allowed by law.
