RESOLUTION 21-12

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT AND / OR LOCAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM(S) AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED, AMENDING OR REPEALING, AS APPLICABLE, ALL RESOLUTIONS OR PROVISIONS THEREIN THAT ARE INCONSISTENT WITH THE APPLICATION AS DESCRIBED, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the State Capital Improvement Program and the Local Transportation Improvement Program both provide financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Newburgh Heights is planning to make capital improvements to Bert Avenue, Ross Avenue, Hermit Avenue, East 27th Street, and East 29th Street, and

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvement herein above described is considered to be a priority need for the community and is a qualified project under the OPWC programs,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Newburgh Heights, Ohio:

Section 1: The Mayor is hereby authorized to apply to the OPWC for funds as described above.


Section 2: The Mayor is authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.

Section 3. Council hereby repeals any resolutions in conflict herewith.

Section 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal action occurred in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the Village, by taking immediate steps to obtain funding for improvements to Bert Avenue, Ross Avenue, Hermit Avenue, East 27th Street, and East 29th Street, which will make a busy, well-traveled roadway in the Village safer and which will forestall obsolescence; wherefore, this resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its adoption and approval by the Mayor.
