**AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE
RECODIFICATION, EDITING, AND INCLUSION
OF CERTAIN ORDINANCES AS PARTS OF THE
VARIOUS COMPONENT CODES OF THE
CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF NEWBURGH
HEIGHTS, OHIO AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, various ordinances of a general and permanent nature have been passed which should be included in the Codified Ordinances of Newburgh Heights, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, numerous sections of the Traffic and General Offenses Codes need to be amended or enacted so as to conform to enactments of the Ohio General Assembly;

WHEREAS, Council has entered into a contract with the Walter H. Drane Company to prepare and publish such revisions which are now before Council,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL of the Village of Newburgh Heights, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. 

SECTION 3. The solicitor shall review the summary prior to forwarding it to the Clerk for publication to ensure that the summary is legally accurate and sufficient.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety for the reason that there exists an imperative necessity for the earliest publication and distribution of the June 2021 Replacement Pages to the Newburgh Heights Codified Ordinances to the officials and residents of the Municipality, so as to facilitate administration, daily operation and avoid legal entanglements, including conflict with general State law.
