VILLAGE OF NEWBURGH HEIGHTS, OHIO**

RESOLUTION NO. 22-15

INTRODUCED BY: Mayor Gigi Traore and All of Council

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HER DESIGNEE TO FILE AN APPLICATION WITH THE CUYAHOGA COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF DEVELOPMENT FOR A COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Administration and Village Council are in agreement that the Village should pursue a grant up to \$150,000 to update the Village's Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Newburgh Heights either has complied or will have complied with all legal requirements and regulations of the Community Development Block Grant to qualify for the requested funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEWBURGH HEIGHTS, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, OHIO, that:

Section 1. Village Council hereby authorizes the Mayor and the administration to do all acts necessary to complete the application process for up to \$150,000.00 Community Development Block Grant Program funds through the Cuyahoga County Community Development Department to update the Village's Master Plan and for any other purposes allowed by applicable law.


Section 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal action occurred in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


Section 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the Village and for the further reason that this ordinance is required to allow the Village to apply for Community Development Block Grant funds, which funds are essential in part because the Village's Master Plan is 10 years old and is in need of being updated; wherefore, this resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its adoption and approval by the Mayor.
