A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FISCAL OFFICER TO TRANSFER EIGHT HUNDRED EIGHT THOUSAND DOLLARS AND ZERO CENTS (\$808,000.00) FROM THE GENERAL FUND (100) TO THE FIRE DEPARTMENT FUND (292), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED, by Council of the Village of Newburgh Heights, County of Cuyahoga and State of Ohio;

SECTION 1. That the Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to TRANSFER EIGHT HUNDRED EIGHT THOUSAND DOLLARS AND ZERO CENTS (\$808,000.00) FROM THE GENERAL FUND (100) TO THE FIRE DEPARTMENT FUND (292).

SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council were in meetings open to the public and in full compliance with all legal requirements, including without limitation, those set forth in 122.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, and for the further reason that it is necessary to authorize the Fiscal Officer to take the action in order to properly reflect the true and accurate balances in all Village funds; wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of four (4) or more of the members elected or appointed to this Council, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest time allowed by law.
